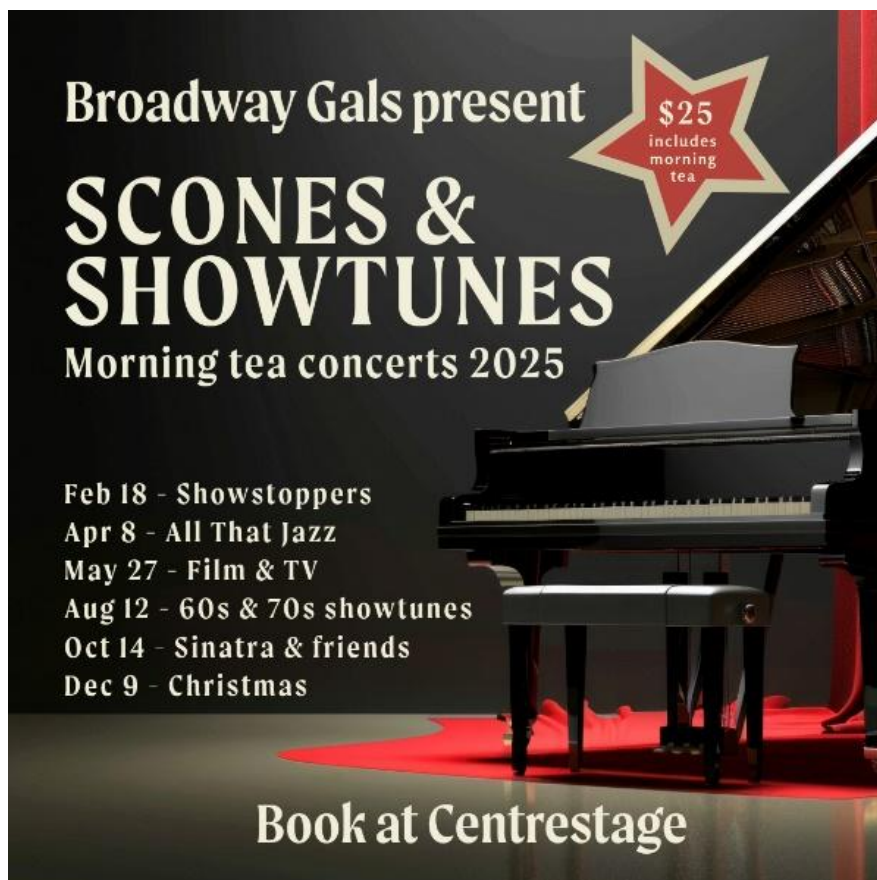


Centrestage Theatre Company Presents: The Wedding Singer (Musical)

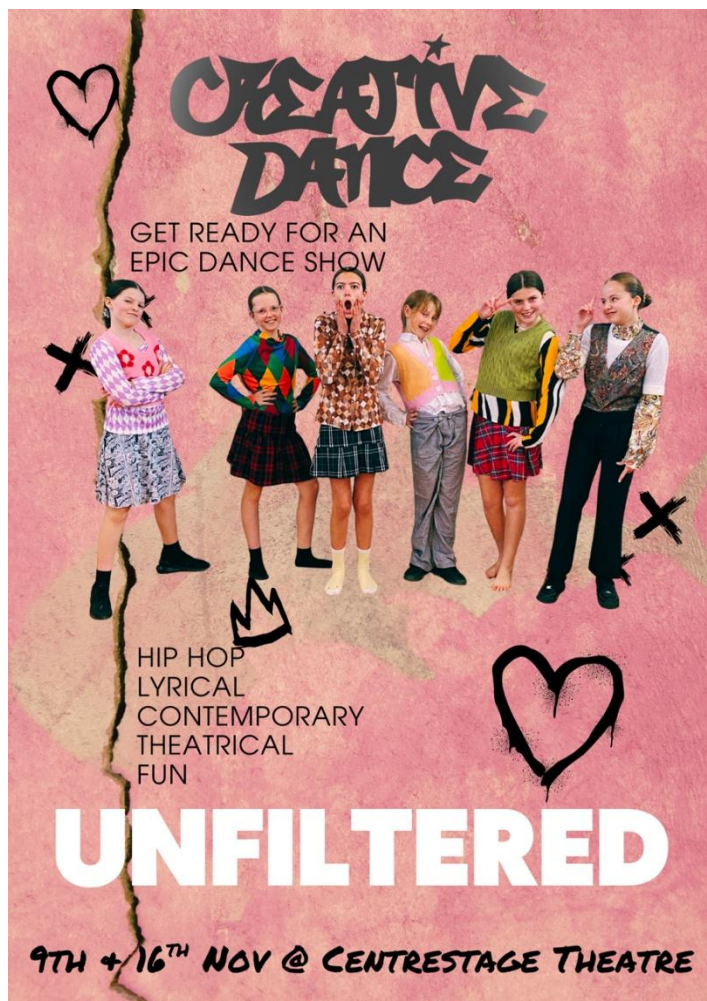
